



SITE SAFETY RULES & ETIQUETTE



PLEASE...

- ♥ be sure you have completed the required forms for receiving therapy and returned them to Trish Penick, RPT.
- ♥ be considerate of vehicles, residents, visitors, dogs, and property while you are visiting Camino Alegre Estates.
- ♥ observe the SPEED LIMIT 15 MPH.
- ♥ park along the road in the widest areas and adjacent to the white split rail fence.
- ♥ do not block pathways, walkways, driveways, mailboxes, or damage vegetation.
- ♥ be kind to our landscaping and plants.
- ♥ keep dogs on a fixed 4 to 6 foot leash. Retractable leashes are not permitted due to their history of serious injury.
- ♥ be advised NO PINCH, PRONG, CHOKE CHAIN, SHOCK COLLARS, OR OTHER AVERSIVE EQUIPMENT IS PERMITTED ON SITE.
- ♥ resolve dog-dog or dog-human aggression in private consultation before appointing for care-- we can assist you with a referral to a qualified professional.
- ♥ if your dog is unwell, or showing signs of respiratory or other infection, leave your dog at home and seek veterinary care. Return when the illness is completely resolved and no longer contagious or transmissible.
- ♥ bathe, brush, & potty your dog prior to your visit.
- ♥ bring poop bags.
- ♥ walk your dog along the street for elimination.
- ♥ clean up after your dog immediately.
- ♥ dispose of your trash in the designated trash receptacles for “dog waste” or “people trash”, or take it with you:
 - empty liquid before placing bottles/containers in trash;
 - no broken glass in trash to avoid injury when changing the trash bag.
- ♥ pick up your dropped treats to minimize disease transmission and gastric distress to other dogs.
- ♥ keep all gates & doors securely closed at all times.
- ♥ maintain a safe distance (at least 10 feet) from other dog-handler teams and people at all times.
